If I go into the gift shop there is a Dilophosaurus that may move and roar.

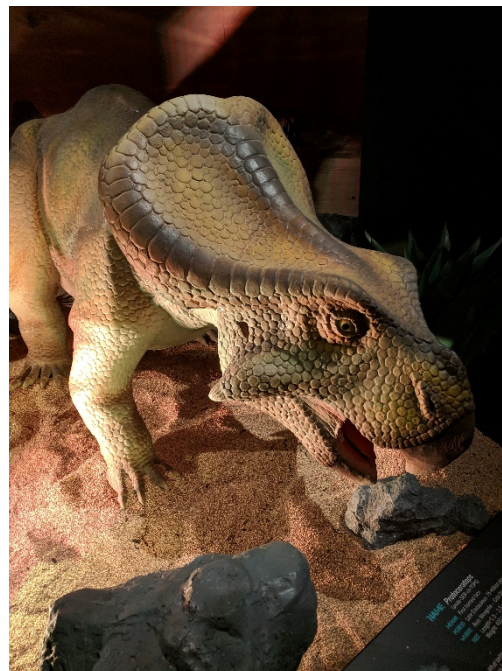
